The Bendigo Bank 7HOFM Carlton Park Surf Festival signals the start of summer and surf sports activities each year in Tasmania. Now in its eight year, the event held on beautiful Carlton Beach aims to engage as many in the community as possible to be active in and around the water. The crystal clear waters of Carlton Beach warm up quickly in November making the venue ideal for a season opener.

#### EVENTS

##### **Strapmark Youth Board Challenge – 10.00am**

Starting at 10.00am, we kick off the day with races for both Malibu and nipper boards. Open, U17, U15, U13 and U11 divisions for both males and females will be conducted over varying M shaped endurance sprint courses depending on weather conditions. This event will be the second round of the Strapmark Youth Board Challenge.

##### **Nippers “Come and Try it” – 11.00am**

Have you thought about getting the kids involved in “Nippers” but are not too sure what it’s all about? Then come along to our “Come and Try it” session starting at 11.00am where you and your kids can learn and participate in our highly regarded junior program. The program focuses on building confidence and skills in and around the surf, promoting an active lifestyle, teamwork and community spirit. Kids can start at the age of 5.

### **YMCA Clearwater Classic Ocean Swim – 12.00pm**

The action will kick off at 12.00 pm with the YMCA Clearwater Classic Ocean Swim with three distances on offer. 1.5km and 500m swims are the first races of the Engine Swimwear Tasmanian Ocean Swim Series. ## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Entry to the event is subject to the following conditions.

Event craft- the event is open to surf boats, SLSA specification and ocean skis, nipper and malibu boards. The Referee has the right to refuse entry to any craft deemed unsuitable. SLSA Specification skis must comply with SLSA craft specifications.

### General Entry Requirements

- All competitors must complete and sign the entry and declaration form and submit at Registration.
- All competitors must read and be familiar with race bulletins and instructions provided at the race briefing.
- All competitors must attend the race briefing.
- The events may endurance in nature and even in cool conditions hydration packs are encouraged together with appropriate sun protection.
- The Event Referee has the right to refuse entry to any craft deemed unsuitable.

All SLSA members wishing to compete in any race category must comply with the following requirements;

- A current financial member of a Surf Life Saving Club
- Must hold a current Bronze Medallion or Junior award and be proficient for the current year.

### Surf Ski Conditions of Entry

- All ski paddlers are required to wear a SLSA approved fluoro top or a Personal Floatation Device (PFD) of a minimum of 50 newton.
- Scrutineering prior to competitors going to the start line will occur.
- Minimum age of entry is 15 years.

### Nipper and Malibu Board Conditions of Entry

- All board paddlers must be a current financial member of a SLSA club.
- All board paddlers must hold an appropriate award for their age group and be proficient for the current competition year.
- All board paddlers must wear a SLSA approved fluoro top.
- Only SLSA approved and compliant boards may be used.

## REGISTRATIONS:

Registration will be taken from 9am at the club. All competitors must register 45 minutes prior to the race start time and attend the race briefing. Competitors will be notified of any course changes at the briefing.

## MARSHALING & BRIEFING:

The Competitor and Officials briefings for each event will take place either at the rear of the clubhouse or on the beach. Listen for PA announcements on timing.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO HELP YOU ON THE DAY:

### Gear drop-off/ pick-up and parking logistics:

Parking at Carlton Park SLSC can often be at a premium and congestion can occur. Please follow the directions of club parking marshals to ensure the safety and comfort of all. Skis and board paddlers

Suggest that you get to the beach in plenty of time and if you are transporting skis and/or boards a drop off section will be maintained. Importantly only stay in this area long enough to drop off gear. Swimmers - carry your bathers, wetsuit and bathers in your left arm. 😊

Please follow the instructions of the parking marshals. Clear access for Emergency Vehicles must be maintained at all times.

### Food and drinks:

A full canteen, BBQ and coffee machine operating during the day.

Stay around for the arvo/evening community celebration. The club bar will be open from late afternoon till late, with meals available from 5.30pm.
